New club/ Society applications

LTU Darts Application:

EM explains this a returning application and EM has met with the club to discuss previous SAC feedback and update application

RW expresses concern over the term crusader

Vote – 5/5 for approve subject to name change

The Trading Hub Application:

EM explains this a returning application and EM has met with the society and support staff twice to discuss previous SAC feedback and update application

Food and Booze Society Application:

EM explains application only sent through yesterday so time to readthrough

EM new society who EM met with day previous to discuss society in more detail

AK expresses concern over food safety, dietary requirements and allergen awareness

DS explains the work LTSU would do with the society around this topic including food safety training with the commercial manager.

EM highlights the objectives in the application which refer to training
