### WHAT IS OUR OPERATING PLAN?

Our operating plan sets out what we want to achieve over the 2020/21 academic year.

In 2020 we concluded year three of our first strategy, the 'Big Plan'. During 2019 the Students' Union undertook substantial research ahead of our next strategy, called 'Beyond 2020'. As a result of the pandemic the trustee board opted for a one year operational plan that developed upon successful outcomes from 2017-20 and introduced pilot projects from our 'Beyond 2020' research. In early 2020 the Students' Union will review its performance via our annual 'Rate Your Union' survey. You can tell us how well we are supporting you ahead of launching our 2021-24 strategic plan. Other outcomes are measured through achieving set goals and activities. Our aim is to achieve our vision of supporting you.



## 1. ADVOCATING FOR STUDENTS' ACADEMIC SUCCESS THROUGH SUPPORT AND REPRESENTATION

Students will have their voice heard and represented by the Union through Course Reps, other elected representatives with Course Rep conferences highlighting the key issues students have shared with us;
