Union Notes

- There are 4 heritage halls which are currently the oldest halls in use on campus. Norwich, Ripon, St Albans and Whitby.
- 2 are self-catered and 2 are part-catered with the self-catered being the “budget accommodation” options for campus.
- Every year all the halls rent fees rise due to inflation.
- Each Heritage Hall holds an average of 44 students.

Union Believes

- Students should be receiving better value for money which the current heritage halls do not reflect.
- The condition of the heritage halls may impact on general health and wellbeing.
- Students shouldn't feel ashamed of which halls they reside in due to poorly maintained facilities.

Union Resolves

- Mandate the President to meet with Estates Team, Accommodation officers, and Exec regarding funding and future improvements.
- Lobby the University to update and improve communal areas including bathrooms, lobbies, and kitchens.
- Work with Health and Safety to make sure that all halls are compliant.
